The Pacific island nation of Kiribati is one of the first that will be underwater in the coming decades with rising sea levels and with more frequent extreme weather.

Dr. Mike Roman, now an academic advisor at the University of Cincinnati, volunteered with the Peace Corps in 2000 and connected with the people of Kiribati. He has returned multiple times, and continues to advocate for their people through the co-founding of Humans of Kiribati. He will be discussing how climate change has impacted the island nation, and what their future may hold with or without intervention.
